## New COVID-19 Assessment Tool Released by the Ministry of Health Employers should screen all individuals prior to entering the workplace

On September 26<sup>th</sup>, 2020, the Ontario government amended order O.Reg. 364/20: Rules for Areas in Stage 3 under the Reopening Ontario Act (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act, 2020 to require businesses to comply with any advice, recommendations, and instructions issued by the Office of the Chief Medical Officer of Health on screening for COVID-19, including screening individuals who wish to enter their premises.

The Ministry of Health has since developed a COVID-19 Screening Tool for Workplaces (Businesses and Organizations) to pro-actively screen employees for COVID-19 symptoms. Employers should have their employees complete the assessment before or when a worker enters the workplace at the beginning of their day or shift, or when an essential visitor arrives.

As outlined in the tool, anyone who does not pass screening should be advised that they should not enter the workplace and should self-isolate, call their health care provider or Telehealth Ontario (1-866-797-0000) to find out if they need a COVID-19 test.
