BREAKING NEWS: Bill 190 Receives Royal Assent

Bill 190, Working for Workers Five Act, 2024

Receives Royal Assent

Late Monday evening, the much-anticipated Bill 190, Working for Workers Five Act, 2024 received Royal Assent. The statutes amended by Bill 190 include:

- Employment Standards Act, 2000 (ESA)
- Occupational Health and Safety Act (OHSA)
- Workplace Safety and Insurance Act, 1997 (WSIA)
- Building Opportunities in the Skilled Trades Act, 2021 (BOSTA)
- Fair Access to Regulated Professions and Compulsory Trades Act, 2006 (FARPACTA)
- Ontario Immigration Act, 2015

The following are the key amendments employers need to be aware of and the dates on which these changes come into effect. **Note:** additional amendments made to the above Acts can be found <u>here</u>.

Employment Standards

Into force at date of Royal Assent (October 28, 2024)

- Increased Fines
- Sick Note Requirements

Into force at date to be named by proclamation

- Duty to Inform Applicants Interviewed
- Confirming Vacancy in Job Postings

Occupational Health and Safety Act

Into force at date of Royal Assent (October 28, 2024)

- Definition of Industrial Establishment
- Definition of Workplace Harassment
- Electronic Posting Requirements
- JHSC Meetings and Posting Requirements
- Telework in Private Residences

Into force at date to be named by proclamation

- Definition of Washroom Facility
- Washroom Facilities
